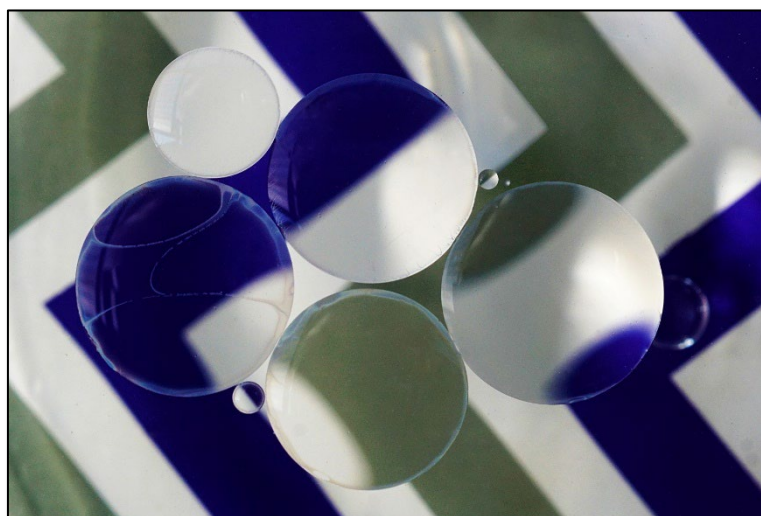

Trefor Ward Guest Speaker 23 August

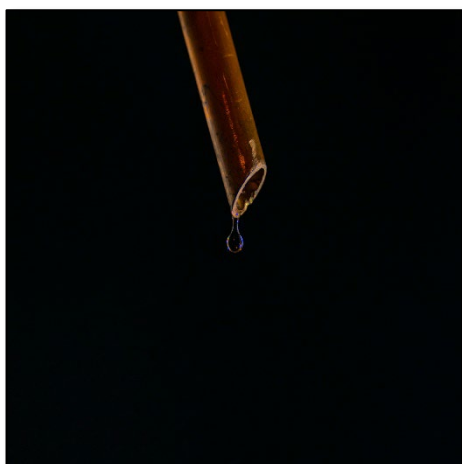

SUBJECTS 2022

Frame within a frame – due 13 September

Frame within a frame is all about positioning your main subject so it's framed by something else within the scene. Think of looking through a keyhole, a parting in the trees or a window or door. You could even use an actual picture frame. The frame could be naturally formed, or you can use props to form the frame. The frame doesn't need to be formed by something in front of the subject, it could be formed by something behind the subject such as a doorway or trees in the distance.

Your frame should form part of the photo and add to the story you are trying to tell. Is it the eyes of a person wearing a headscarf, a secret garden behind a gate, your first glimpse of the beach through the trees, a person enjoying a smoke at the entrance to an alleyway, or a dismal blurry day through the window of a bright room?

Waikato My Home – due 11 October

People, places, activities and events that represent the Waikato region or the town where you live in the Waikato. A photo of something typical of the Waikato, or at least that someone would recognise as being in or from the Waikato. Think of the cows in Morrinsville, the Te Awamutu rose garden, rowers on Lake Karapiro, or Balloons over Waikato.

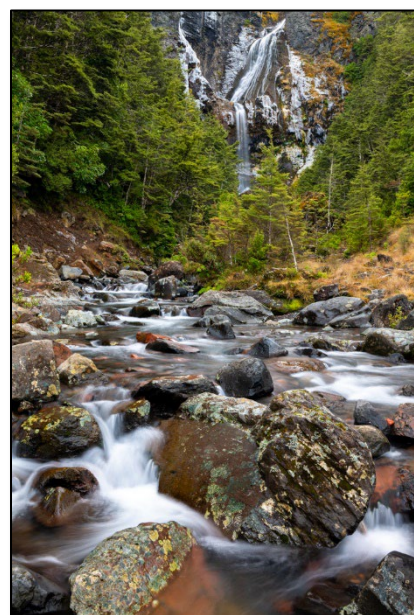

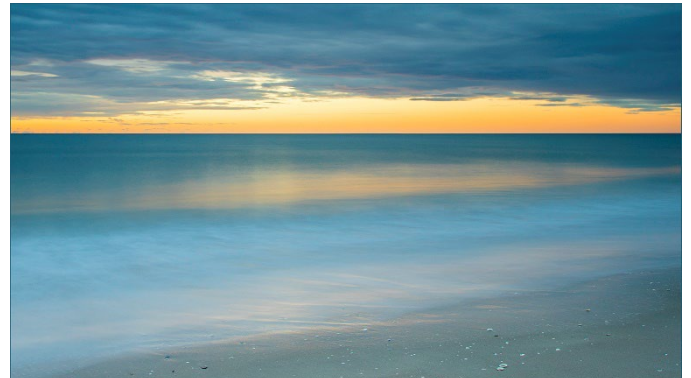

Supper

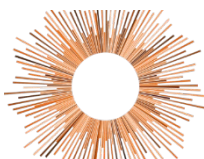
